Every two seconds, someone needs blood. Every minute, patients use more than 36 units of blood or blood products. Every day, approximately 40,000 units of blood are used throughout the country. Despite the urgent need for more donors, less than 5% of healthy Americans actually donate each year. Giving blood is safe, simple and takes less than an hour. Each unit of blood, which is just less than a pint, can be separated into four components-red cells, plasma, cryoprecipitate, and platelets.
